Andrea Garcia Vasquez (b. 1992, USA) is a visual artist based in Leipzig, Germany. AGV focuses on using textile-based materials and techniques to realize her art works, ranging from 2 dimensional tapestries and quilts, to video, to large-scale or site-specific installations. She received her BFA from the School of Visual Arts in New York City (2014) and is currently studying for her Diploma at the Hochschule für Grafik und Buchkunst, Leipzig. AGV won 5th place prize in the student category for the Art Olympia International Art Competition in Tokyo 2017, had her first solo exhibition in Beirut, Lebanon, and participated internationally in group exhibitions in: New York, Brooklyn, Newark, Seoul, Malaga, and Leipzig.

At the Foundation Jetty, Andrea Garcia Vasquez is showing her latest experimentations of storytelling with textile techniques and sculpture. Her works reference a de-constructed quilt, combining text and image to create a narrative of love and longing. "Horizontally Parallel" investigates nature and how it biologically functions [with or without humans] and the complex efforts put into human-to-human relationships. This combination leaves the viewer with a love letter of sorts that the artist wrote in hopes of redeeming Mother Earth's love.
