


Jacopo Grilli



"The city as a living artwork" is a selection of paintings that reflect on the status of the human being in the urban context, executed between February and March 2023 during an art residency at NDSM Art City.

The city is the most complex human invention; it is the representation of society, with its mistakes, adjustments, successes, failures, and its monumental hopes and desperations. Every work reflects on the role of the human as the creator and beneficiary of the city. The human figure and its shadow, the volume and the detail of the city, the nature and the emptiness, are the universal themes of the works. As a journey, the sequence of works starts from the past of dealing with changes; the exchange city, like Venice, and agriculture are just details in comparison to the majestic project of the human being. Its presence is dominant and elegant, without a clear identity if not as a universal creator of knowledge and cultural progress. "Beneath, below, behind"- that is an illusion.

The reflection follows a spatial consideration of the amount of city, nature, and emptiness that one human needs: "The Amount". Almost a mathematical equation for what only a shadow can reach - a glimpse of spatial necessity that is eating up the entire planet. "City dust" is the fainted individual on an urban carpet, laid out to support our life, nothing more, nothing less. Dusty, misty, and polluted is the environment that the human prefers.

At this point, the journey takes a twist of hope and the stubborn direction of one who finally accepts their fate and mission - an effort: "The Effort" - the effort of hugging a hill, of filling up an abyss of misbehaviors and abuses upon our hosting landscape. To be very honest, the effort is a childish dream to lay on a green hill soft of grass and warmed up by the sun. The effort is a hope for all creatures with two powerful but dangerous hands - hands that can heal and hurt, caress or scratch.

From here, we look at the future, a new version of the past, like a medieval center, like a perched city, like a berry cake after a spinach soup - something contrasting but maybe needed. "In the end, at the bottom of our stomach, everything is dark", as a wise man used to say.

"Path of the light, the shadows and the empty" is the realization that the form of our habitat is a combination of full, empty, darkness and light. A sweet unhealthy landscape crossed by a ferrous infrastructure. "You can have your cake after you finish your veggies." This is what the city is. We tend to forget the necessary steps for achieving pleasure, happiness, and realization.

The visual journey goes to an incomplete work: "Let's flood in love." Finally, we accept our fate, but we still want a chance to design it. A merchant-oriented, warehouse-populated, floating and to-be-flooded city is going to appear. The speculation of our living with nature, in balance with cultures, and supported by our only efforts is going to repay us finally. With a dramatic view of our doing, Venice is back, Amsterdam is added, Hamburg goes along, for a tiny New York-ish lifestyle: it is the dream of the contemporary man.

To conclude this landslide of images and feelings, the tiniest and greatest reward to our actions and thoughts, as far as any antipodes, is the ecosystem - the eco-system, an echo system. "Echo-system" signifies the smallest and most revolutionary attempt, effort, amount, and compliment we could give to ourselves - to have created an artwork, an ecosystem, a nature-matching habitat: the city as a living artwork.









The Effort




(berry cake after a spinach soup)









Echo-system
